# Restore Iraqi Oil Program



**Details:**

- In 2003, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) tasked KBR with the mission to evaluate and repair Iraq's petroleum infrastructure; implement a contingency plan to assess and extinguish oil well fires in Iraq; provide fuel distribution in Iraq; and provide technical support to Iraqi refining and distribution operations.
- KBR's work included assessing and repairing Iraqi oil and gas infrastructure, performing fire suppression on wells and other facilities, making emergency repairs to fire-damaged equipment and facilities, and restoring hydrocarbon systems through startup and operations on wellheads, gathering and degassing systems, refineries, pipelines and the main offshore oil loading terminal.
